

VIRGINIA HEART INSTITUTE ♥ Physician Opportunities

BACKGROUND

Virginia Heart Institute was established in 1972 as a licensed outpatient hospital specifically designed to validate the safety of ambulatory coronary arteriography, which was approved by Medicare in 1988 for outpatient facilities. The faculty at the Medical College of Virginia has been extremely helpful in regard to development of this facility through the Departments of Medicine, Surgery and Anesthesia.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The Virginia Heart Institute's plan is to create an Internal Medicine Clinic integrating outpatient care with high technology services including CT and eventually MRI. The growth in this field, particularly when coupled with molecular medicine, will serve as an exciting opportunity for academically oriented staff integrating technology with clinical medicine in a multidisciplinary imaging center.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Physicians will provide support to the patients referred to Virginia Heart Institute for evaluation and this will include: history and physical, selection of diagnostic tests and follow-up care. A certain percentage of these patients do not have long-term delivery service, primary care or ambulatory support; therefore, the physicians at Virginia Heart Institute will provide this service which will include night, emergency and weekend coverage. In the future, other subspecialties will be represented and will include renal, cardiopulmonary, and endoscopy services.

A salary and benefit package will be available and competitive to local programs. An additional advantage is that hospital activities will be integrated as far as payment of services and will encourage the utilization of the most advanced training in computer systems to maximize a new health care system.
